Puedes utilizar "There's" (= Hay) y "There are" para decir lo que hay en un lugar

Utiliza There's / There is + un sustantivo singular (= 1 cosa):

**There's a park in my neighborhood**



# THERE'S Y THERE ARE

Utiliza There are + un sustantivo plural (= 2 o más cosas):

**There are three restaurants**

# QUANTIFIERS / CUANTIFICADORES

**A / an significan ambos uno. Usa a / an con sustantivos singulares:**

There's a park. (La primera letra de park no es a, e, i, o, ni u)

There's an outdoor café. (La primera letra de café al aire libre es o.)

There's one park and there's one outdoor café.
